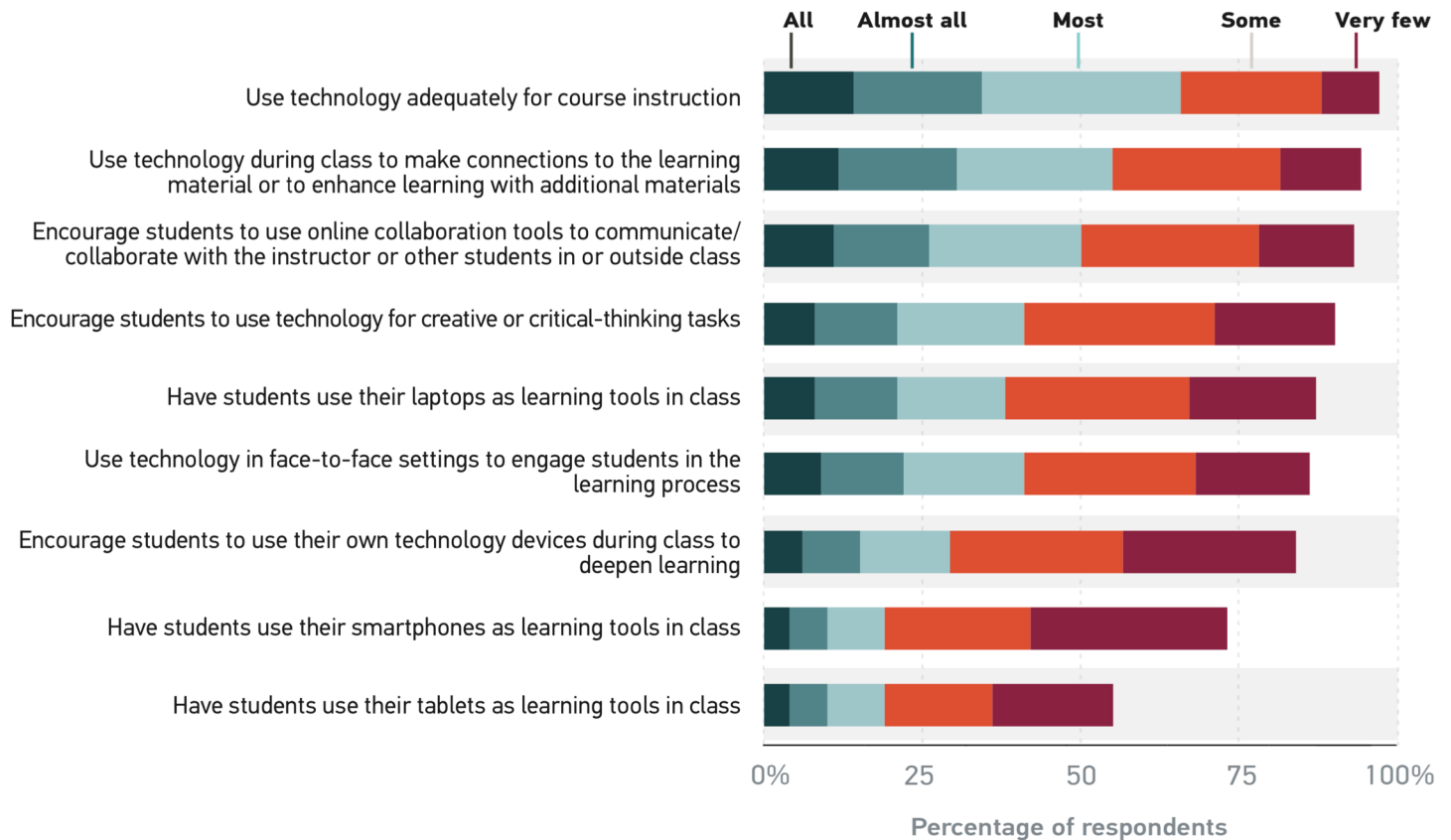

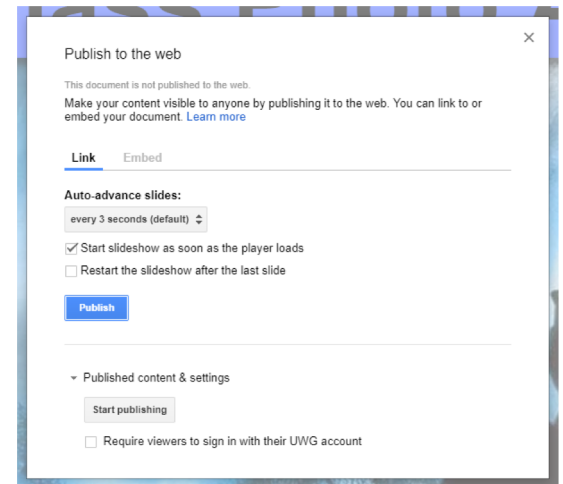

## Instructions for Creating Photo Album (for in-class announcements at start of lesson)

1. Click **File** then "Make a copy" to create your own photo album.
2. Change the background photo used on slide 2.
3. Add new slides (by clicking the + on top left).
4. Insert content (photos, messages, etc.) into the slides.
5. If this is a Group album, give edit access by clicking "Share" (top right).
6. When ready, click "Publish to the web" from the file menu.
7. After clicking "publish," you will receive a shareable link.
